

The Whistleblower House (TWBH) is a not-for-profit, public benefit organisation that provides access to support services for whistleblowers, raises awareness of their plight, and champions their crucial role in strengthening ethics and democracy in South Africa. While protecting whistleblowers is the government's duty, TWBH steps in where support is lacking.

Though still a young organisation, TWBH is learning and growing. Since our inception, we have supported over 400 whistleblowers who might otherwise have had no help. These individuals risk their careers, reputations, and safety to expose corruption, injustice, environmental crimes, financial fraud, and human rights violations, often at great personal cost. Many face retaliation, legal battles, and emotional distress, left without income or protection while fighting for transparency that benefits us all.

Trust is everything at TWBH; we maintain strict anonymity and confidentiality to protect their safety and dignity.

We believe no one should have to stand alone for doing the right thing.

OUR SERVICES



Legal Support – Connecting whistleblowers with legal practitioners for confidential advice and ensuring adherence to procedures that protect their rights.



Psychological Support – Collaborating with professionals to offer trauma-informed care tailored to each whistleblower's needs, addressing PTSD, depression, and anxiety along their path to recovery.



Financial Assistance – Providing financial support in the form of a monthly stipend to help whistleblowers cover essential living costs during this critical period, easing the burden as they focus on their safety and recovery.



Safety & Security – Arranging safe relocation or collaboration with partners providing secure housing.

DEFINITION OF A WHISTLEBLOWER

A person who, in good faith, reports unlawful or immoral activity within an organisation to an individual or entity they believe will act appropriately.
